1. The research phase. DIESIS will elaborate on the research methodology and guidelines of the **current state of affairs in the field of youth employment and social entrepreneurship** in the target countries. This analysis will be based on **current social entrepreneurship penetration rates**, an in-depth review of the **specific social needs** (also in relation to the health or social care sector) and their **relevant indicators**, as these have been shaped by the **current economic climates** in the target countries, as well as **currently available education/training material** provided by established education institutions **in the fields of entrepreneurship and business administration**.

2. Focus groups. Each partner will organize **2 focus groups** (min.5 participants each), 1 with young people with **academic or professional experience in health or social care field** and 1 with **experienced entrepreneurs and economic actors**, involving them and gathering information on the **skills and knowledge needs of young aspiring social entrepreneurs**.

3. Quantitative survey (via questionnaires)
